

 Sustainable Development starts with Education as an integral part of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development where All SDGs are interdependent


SDG4 and Incheon Declaration: World Education Forum, 19 – 22 May 2015, Incheon, Republic of Korea

UNESCO together with UNICEF, the World Bank, UNFPA, UNDP, UN Women and UNHCR organized the World Education Forum 2015. Over 1,600 participants from 160 countries, including over 120 Ministers, adopted the **Incheon Declaration for** Education 2030, which sets out a new vision for education for the next fifteen years.



Issue: Are we ready to work with GenZ?

- Digital generation (GEN Z): challenges, defined by the new environment and new social situation of sustainable development—
- Changes of top mental (psychic) functions (memory, attention, thinking, perception, speech etc);
- Changes of usual qand traditional cultural and social practices (modes of activity) –
 Internet as a cultural tool for solving different tasks by new but not traditional ways;
- Changes of mechanisms for the development of child personality (identity, Status, Reputation, Accumulation of
- Social capital, personal and individual features);
- Appearnce of new Psychological contexts (Social media and networks, blogosphere, virtual worlds, etc) as well as Phenomena (Internet dependence, multitasking, Facebook depression, Google-effect, etc);
- Appearance of new forms of interrelation development including The negative aggressive ones (flaming, Flooding, Spaming, trolling, hackering, haytering, cyberbooling, suicidegrouping, etc);


