It has professional preparation and educational competence and capacity in the fields of: Library and Information Sciences, Social Communications; Informatics and Computer Sciences and National Security. The University offers 15 Bachelor and 26 Master programmes in these areas, as well as a number of Doctoral programmes. ULSIT's social mission is to prepare highly qualified, socially responsible, personally motivated and adaptive to the labor market specialists.



The University has the strategic aim for sustainable development as a leading higher school with a significant scientific, technological and innovative potential.
